Dr. Lertsiri Bovornkitti is currently an Assistant Professor of Art Education and Art Therapy at the Faculty of Fine Arts, Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok, Thailand. Beside teaching art education for both undergraduate and postgraduate programs, he took up intensive research in art therapy through his own interest and several trainings from foreign experts.

Dr. Lertsiri's teaching experience has expanded across a number of courses in art education and fine arts, especially art therapy that made him quite well-recognized among scholars in the field. He has been invited to present the works at various institutions both in Thailand and abroad. The significant researches focused on the art expressions in children and traumatized persons, as well as art therapy with post natural disasters victims, in which he published more than fifty academic papers, and an author of two textbooks. He also own two translated and edited books. For many years, Dr. Lertsiri had been involved in the international relations aspect, engaging academic collaboration with various foreign institutions. He continues to serve the university and the public on education, child and human development, art activities, and academic journal editorial work. In October 2013, he has been appointed as an Associate Fellow of the Royal Society of Thailand to serve in the Arts Academy.
